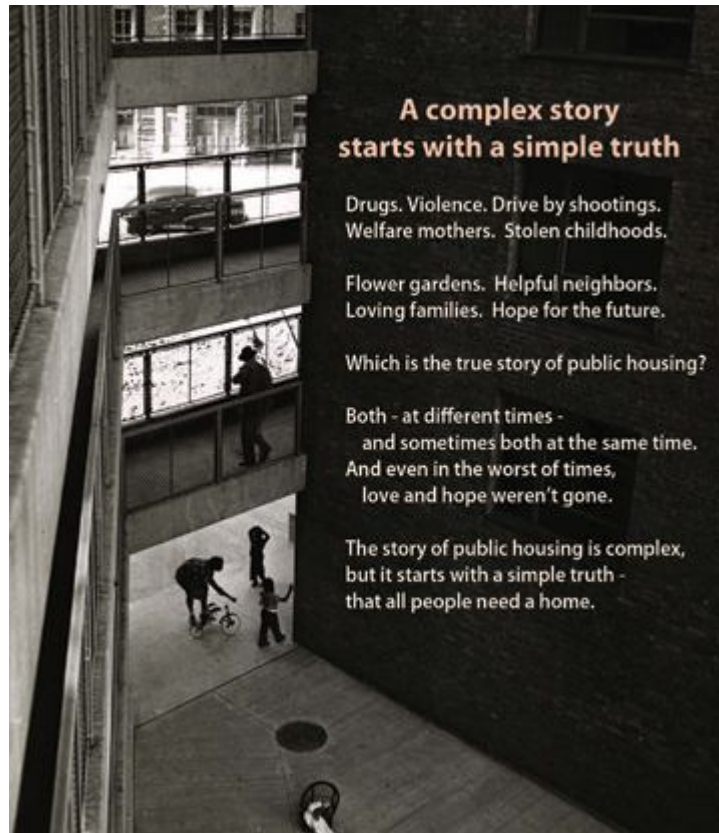


Re-Opening
